

### **Biography of Speaker:**

#### Anderson Cheuk-kuen KWAN (Cert.Ed., B.Sc., M.Sc., M.Ed., MACE)

He has got a conditional offer of PhD study before from the UCL Institute of Education which ranks World No.1 for Education since 2014 up to now– QS World University Rankings by Subject (https://www.ucl.ac.uk/ioe/). The topic of his approved proposal is about the research study of mathematically gifted student education.

Since 2018, he was invited to be a coordinator of the Hong Kong Branch of the World Giftedness Centre which commences operations in close collaboration with the United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (UNESCO).

In addition, he was also a founding member of the special interest group for Gifted Education, Creativity and Talent Development (CAISE), Faculty of Education, University of Hong Kong. Besides, he has been acting as a course designer and part-time lecturer of gifted programmes of CAISE since 2016 as well as had a sharing to HKU M.Ed. students regarding a course design for mathematically gifted students.

He was invited by the Review and Planning Section, Education Bureau (EDB) as well as the Faculty of Education, HKU respectively to be a guest speaker to conduct a sharing to secondary teachers and HKU M.Ed. students how to conduct math lessons in English Medium Instruction.

He has been an HKU mentor since 2017 and his sharing of being aa mentor will be published in autumn in Education Matters of Faculty of Education at HKU.

He who was seconded to Mathematics Education Section, EDB for 2 years, is now a committee member and an adjudicator of EDB Math Book Report Competition since 2009 and a member of Task Quality Assurance Committee for Math at Secondary Level, EDB as well.

At last, he also published a journal in 2013 jointly written with an HKU associate professor regarding the design of the programmes about gifted education in Math in Gifted and Talented International Journal as well as another paper about the design rationale and implementation of mathematically gifted programs in 2019 School Mathematics Newsletter Vol. 22 published by Mathematics, Math Ed. Section, CDI, EDB. He was also invited to be a commentor on gifted programmes offered by a local university and an international journal respectively.


## **Qualities for a Good teacher**

- To learn good things from colleagues




# Qualities for a Good teacher (Cont'd)

- Life long learning

- Be familiar with the most updated words used by teenagers such as "姜粉"













## Important skills to include in a teacher resume

1. Proof of your Chinese and English writing skills such as competitions, professional courses attended, IELTs and so on

- 2. Different language skills especially for top banding schools
- 3. Proof of your experiences of conducting education researches, if any
- 4. Proof of your experiences in writing some proposals for application for some activities' fundings
- 5. Proof of other generic skills such as participating in international sports competitions, music performances, local drama production and so on

6. Proof of your awards for international academic competitions such as Math Olympic, Physics Olympic and so on
