Lecture on "Developing Transpositioning Capacities for Educational Futures in the 21st Century Through Co-Learning" by Professor Li Wei

The Faculty of Education of The University of Hong Kong (HKU) will hold the Distinguished Lecture on **"Developing Transpositioning Capacities for Educational Futures in the 21st Century Through Co-Learning"** to be delivered by Professor Li Wei of University College London on July 18 (Thursday). Professor Li is also appointed as Hung Leung Hau Ling Distinguished Visiting Professor in the Humanities and Social Sciences at HKU in 2023-24.
