  - 1. A short paragraph on your view of "How could creative learning enhance students' learning motivation?"
  - 2. Your updated CV.
- Shortlisted students may be invited to attend an interview arranged by AFTEC (details to be confirmed).

- Did I choose these projects based on intuition and prior assumptions and how accurate are they?


