### BABEd (Lang Ed) English Admission procedures 2020

- Interviews will be conducted mid to late July after announcement of HKDSE results
- An interview is <u>not</u> guaranteed. You will be selected for interview based on the overall strength of your full application.
- You are strongly advised to put this programme in Band A, first choice



## <u>Minimum</u> Admissions Requirements for JUPAS

To satisfy the minimum requirements for entrance to the University, each applicant shall gain the following in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE):

- Level 3 or above in English language;
- Level 3 or above in Chinese language;
- Level 2 or above in Mathematics;
- Level 2 or above in Liberal Studies; and
- Level 3 or above in two Elective Subjects.



## BABEd (Lang Ed) English Selection process

- English Language score is <u>very</u> important (last year, all had Level 5 or above)
- Heavier weighting for English and Liberal Studies
- Bonus points are given for English Literature and History
- Your whole application will be reviewed including personal statement and extra curricular activities
- Your interview will be carefully considered
