#### (1) Overview

#### BEd&BSc degree curriculum

- is jointly offered by the Faculty of Education and the Faculty of Science
- o is a 5-year teacher education programme with **NO** exit point
- integrates and allows concurrent studies of Major and Professional Core courses and participation in exchange and experiential programmes during 5 years
- awards two degrees on graduation
- aims at providing professional training equivalent to a Postgraduate Diploma in Education but longer in duration



#### (1) Overview

#### BEd&BSc degree curriculum

- leads to a recognised teacher training qualification in Hong Kong. Graduates can become a teacher of Science subjects in Hong Kong primary and secondary schools
- allows also the development / career options available to Science graduates
- has 16 first-year places
- will consider admitting candidates with different educational backgrounds









- 120 credits in Education Professional Core courses
  - Integrated Courses
  - Pedagogy Courses
  - Pedagogical Content Knowledge Courses
  - Educational Studies Core Courses
  - Educational Studies Elective Courses



- Before the end of Year 3:
   Community-based Professional Practicum
- 20-week of Professional Practicum in 2 blocks
  - Year 4: 10 weeks in a primary school
  - Year 5: 10 weeks in a secondary school




- 24 credits in Common Core Curriculum
- 12 credits in Chinese and English language courses, including a noncredit bearing Academic Communication in English course
- 6 credits in artificial intelligence literacy
- a non-credit bearing course in national education and national security education, and any other non-credit bearing courses as may be required from time to time
- Remaining credits for free electives in:
  - experiential learning programmes;
  - minor programme;
  - education and inter-faculty elective courses, etc.

# JUPAS Admissions: Programme Entrance Requirements

JS6119	
English Language	Level 3 or above
Chinese Language	Level 3 or above
Mathematics	Level 2 or above
Citizenship and Social Development	Attained (A)
Elective subjects	Level 3 or above in two subjects, with at least one in Biology, Chemistry or Physics

Other Language subjects will be used as unspecified elective subjects.



#### **JUPAS Admissions: Selection Criteria**

- BEd&BSc requires Best 5 subject scores
- Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics or M1/M2 are weighed slightly heavier in computing the overall score of applicants
- Other tie-breakers may be employed



#### Non-JUPAS Admissions: Minimum Requirements

Candidates with different educational backgrounds are required to satisfy each of the following basic University and Programme Entrance Requirements:

- General Academic Requirements under
  - either International Qualifications e.g. International Baccalaureate Diploma, GCE A-level etc.
  - or National / Regional Qualifications e.g. Singapore's GCE A-Level examination, South Korea's General High School Diploma, etc; and
- English language requirement

# (4) Question & Answer



## Frequently Asked Questions (1)

Do I have to put your programme as my Band A (i.e. top 3 choices) in JUPAS or 1<sup>st</sup> choice in non-JUPAS to enhance my chance of being admitted?

Yes, only applicants who have put the programme as their Band A (i.e. top 3 choices) in JUPAS or 1<sup>st</sup> choice in non-JUPAS will be favourably considered.



# Frequently Asked Questions (2)

If I am applying on the basis of my HKDSE results, how will my application be evaluated?

Selection will be primarily based on applicants' results in the best 5 subjects. The best 5 subjects must include English Language, Mathematics and the best Science elective subject\*, plus the best two among the remaining subjects. M1/M2 can be included.

Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics or M1/M2 are weighed slightly heavier.

\* "Science elective subject" refers to one of the following subjects, namely Biology, Chemistry and Physics.



# Frequently Asked Questions (3)

Is there any quota for JUPAS and non-JUPAS applicants? How many students were admitted through the non-JUPAS exercise?

There are no fixed quotas for JUPAS and non-JUPAS applicants for the BEd&BSc curriculum. Each applicant is assessed based on academic merits.



## **Frequently Asked Questions (4)**

Will I be granted interviews?

There will be no interview for JUPAS candidates in general.



# Frequently Asked Questions (5)

Can I apply via JUPAS and non-JUPAS admissions schemes at the same time?

Applicants can only submit one application through any one of the schemes in the same admissions year.

Duplicate applications under a particular admissions scheme or across different admissions schemes will NOT be considered by the University and application fees paid are non-refundable.



#### **Frequently Asked Questions (6)**

Can I apply for direct entry to Year 2 or 3?

You cannot apply for direct entry to the senior year of the BEd&BSc curriculum because it is a professional degree curriculum and students are required to complete the entire programme.



## Frequently Asked Questions (7)

When is the deadline for non-JUPAS applicants to send supporting documents?

We will start reviewing applications when they are received. Applicants should send supporting documents to the University within 2 weeks after the submission of application or as soon as possible when updated results / transcripts are received during the year.



## Frequently Asked Questions (8)

Can I choose to take any one of the 14 majors from the Faculty of Science as my subject major?

No, BEd&BSc students can only take **one** of the 7 approved majors (slide 8) as their subject major.

Mathematics, Decision Analytics, Risk management, Statistics, Earth System Science, Environmental Science and Geology major programmes are <u>not</u> on the list. <u>Nevertheless, students</u> may take these as minor by using their credits for electives.
