

Why BSc(IM) so special?


- First such degree programme offered by a local university

Aims

Designed to prepare graduates to:

- be informed, reflective practitioners in the information age
- develop information leadership capacities that can be used in a wide variety of professional environments



Programme features

- Extends over 2 academic years of FT study
- Face-to-face coursework, combined with flexible online delivery
- Interaction with IM industry through professional experience (internship)
- Opportunity for in-depth research in final year project



Eligibility and intake quota

Candidates holding a recognized full-time <u>Higher Diploma</u> or <u>Associate Degree</u> programme in any disciplines of at least two years duration in Hong Kong are eligible.

Since 2005, more than 300 students have graduated. The intake quota for 2018-19 is 50.

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Articulation
