Key Learning Area: Personal, Social and Humanities Education (PSHE)

Major: Geography (Full-time and Part-time)

The Geography major course aims to provide intending teachers of geography with skills and awareness which will enable them to develop professional standing through:

- 1. a knowledge of the changes taking place in geographical education and within 21st century education in general
- 2. a knowledge and deep understanding of the educational purposes of geography within the key learning area of Personal, Social and Humanities Education (PSHE) in the school curriculum in Hong Kong
- 3. an awareness and knowledge about the problems pupils face in learning geography and seeing ways to minimize those difficulties
- 4. an understanding of the pedagogical considerations, key principles and techniques of planning a geography course appropriate to diverse classroom situations
- 5. an understanding of the approaches allowing development of well-structured and coherent lessons
- 6. an ability to use multiple strategies for assessing learning
- 7. a capability in identifying the principles and structures of the existing syllabi of geography in Hong Kong schools
- 8. an understanding of the new cultural shift in aligning learning, teaching and assessment
- 9. an awareness and knowledge to develop as reflective teachers, fostering on-going professional development
